This letter is to inform you of the arrangements for IGCSE (Year 11), AS (Year 12) and A2 (Year 13) Final Mock Examinations that will start place next week and run from Monday, April 1st to Friday, April 12th. The mock examinations will not only test knowledge and understanding, but also key examination skills, such as time management. The mock examination timetable has been included as an attachment to this email. Please ensure that your son/daughter receives a copy of this timetable.

The grades that they achieve will be reported in a final mock examination report, along with subject comments, that you will receive at the end of this term, before your son/daughter goes on Study Leave, prior to their external exams.

It will be important for all Year 11, 12 and 13 students to focus and to organise a revision timetable for the Easter holiday to ensure they achieve the best possible grades in their external exams. They of course should already have begun this process if they are to achieve the best grades possible.
