# THE MAKER'S CLUB - Year 3 to Year 6

The Maker's Club is all about transforming how children see the everyday world around them. Instead of simply using objects, participants will learn to look closer—asking what is this made of? and how was it created? Through hands-on, exciting activities, they'll discover the hidden stories behind ordinary items and gain the skills to make their own.

In this club, children will explore natural and everyday materials, experimenting with how they can be transformed. They'll try their hand at making simple tools, mixing paints from mud, oxides, and other natural sources, and crafting useful items such as candles, soaps, deodorants, body creams, and crayons. Every session is designed to spark curiosity, creativity, and a sense of independence, turning "how is it made?" into a joyful adventure.

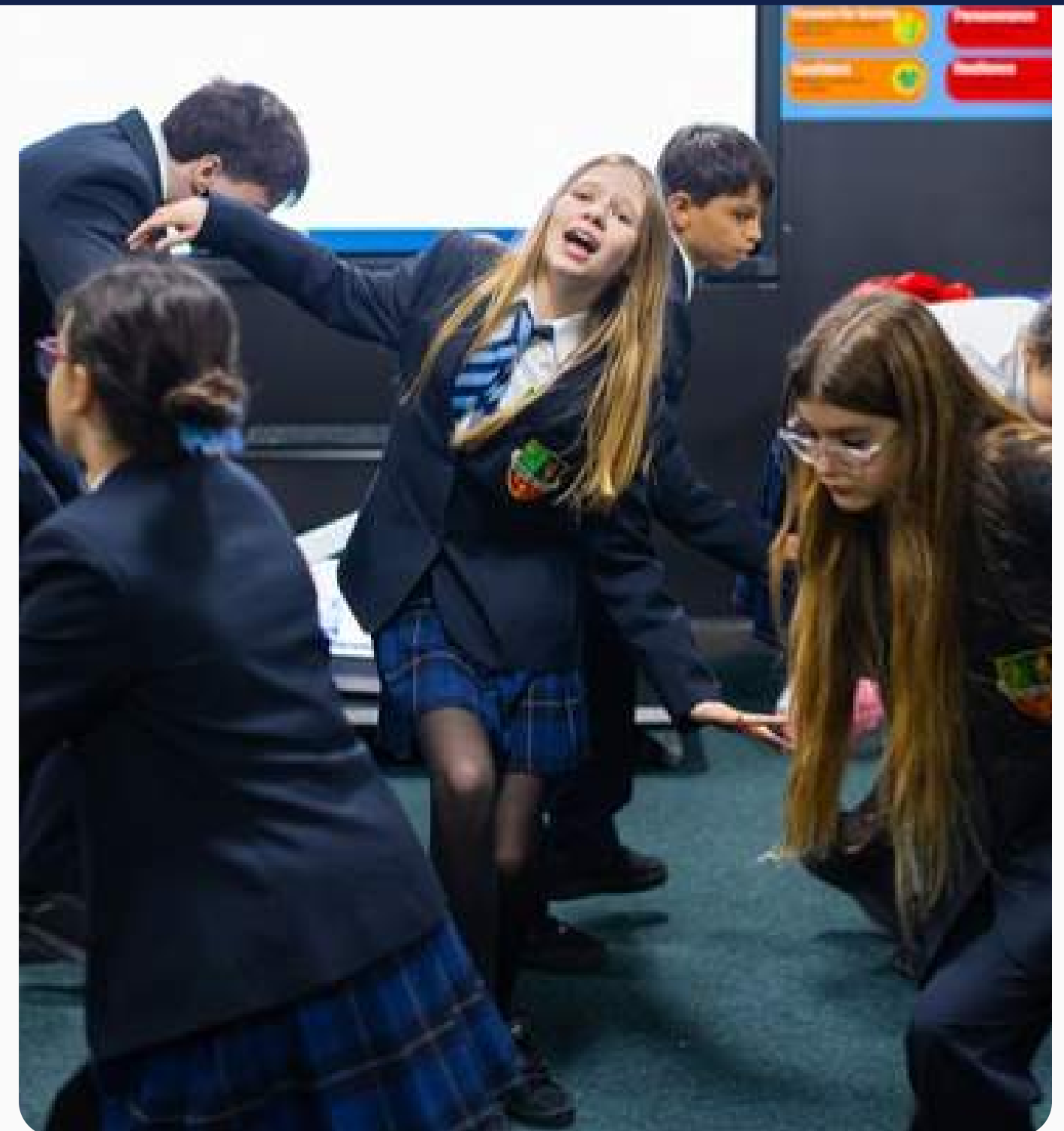

The workshops will be facilitated by Adrian Loghin, an actor and experienced theatre workshop developer with a wealth of experience in working with children and teenagers, and Andreea Lucaci, also an actor, young theatre director, and seasoned teacher of theatre techniques applied for children.

### Year 4 to Year 6

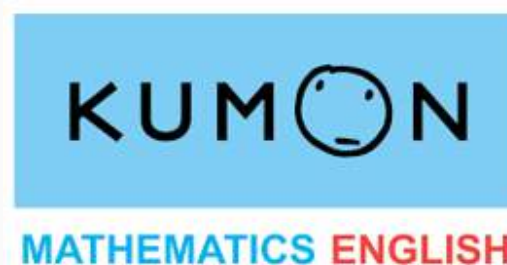

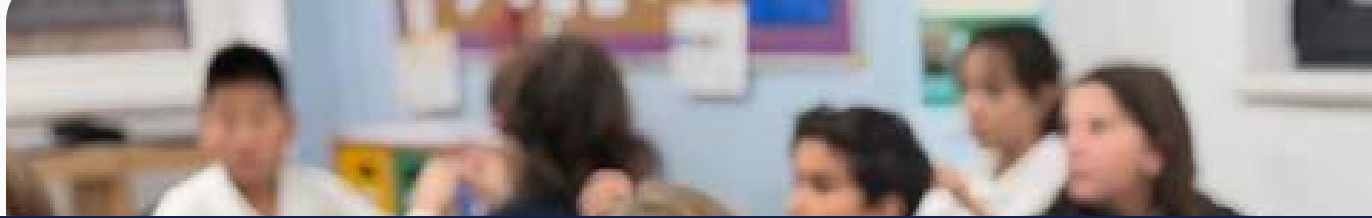
# KIDS YOGA CLUB

## Year 2 - Year 6

Kids Yoga (ages 3-5, 6-8, 9-12) is a non-spiritual, non-religious program that promotes the development of a strong and flexible body, increases balance, mind-body awareness and coordination, improves posture and alignment, reduces stress and anxiety, increases concentration, focus, and attention span.

In Kids Yoga, children learn the foundations of yoga through storytelling, creative imagery, music, songs, speech, and communication, use of props, and creative movement in a non-religious and non-spiritual manner. The program aims to build children's self-confidence, self-esteem, and self-expression as they develop muscular strength and flexibility, balance, coordination, and mental focus. The practice of mindfulness and conscious breathing are incorporated to enhance the development of mind and body connection as we nurture the process of self-regulation, stress management, and relaxation.





## WOW LAB CLUB - Year 1 to Year 6



Why should my child participate at Wow Lab workshops?

- To enrich his or her knowledge about natural phenomena around us
- To understand and use scientific terms and concepts
- To prepare for the study of sciences in formal education
- To develop his or her personal skills: individual and team work, synthesis and analysis, presentation skills
- To improve his or her critical thinking, analysis and conceptualization through observing, understanding and explaining the effects of the experiments.



## CAPOIERA CLUB - Year 1 to Year 6
